



Disaster Ministry Updates

With Appreciation – August was fundraising month for S. Ohio/KY BDM. There were 330 people in attendance at the Ice Cream Social, raising about \$9,100. The Golf Scramble that was held with Camping & Retreat Ministries had 23 teams, and we're awaiting the amount raised. The Darke County Fair parking at Orthopedic Associates had proceeds of \$3,000. We appreciate the support of the S. Ohio/KY District! Rebuilding Sites - A new long-term BDM rebuilding site opens in September in Letcher County, KY. This is in southeastern Kentucky, where flooding occurred in July 2022, BDM is partnering with HOMES, Inc., an organization that was already working on affordable, sustainable housing prior to the flooding event. BDM will build new homes and do repairs on ones that were flood damaged. We'll have crews working Sept. 8-14 and Nov. 17-23. Volunteers are needed for the November crew. The short-term site that will be open for ten weeks this fall is in Dawson Springs, KY. BDM has already served here and will now be completing homes that we started, as well as build two more.
